Plague of the Firstborn

Distinction between Israel and Egypt (11:7)

- Egypt – Death and of Great Sadness (Verse 6) - Punishment
- Israel – Vehicle of Deliverance

Plague of the Firstborn

Distinction between Israel and Egypt (11:7)

- Egypt – Death and of Great Sadness (Verse 6) – Punishment
 - He is the Lord (Ex 5:2)
 - Let My people Go.....(Ex 10:3)

Plague of the Firstborn

Distinction between Israel and Egypt (11:7)

- Egypt – Punishment was universal
 - Firstborn of the house of Pharaoh
 - Firstborn of the slave girl
 - Firstborn of the cattle
 - Against the gods of Egypt (Num 33:4; Is 19:1)

Plague of the Firstborn

Punishment is Sure and universal

Exodus 34:6-7 & Job 10:14

Rom 3:23 – All have sinned.....

Rom 6:23 – The wages of sin is Death....

Plague of the Firstborn

God warns us before He punishes

- The previous plagues of Egypt
- Noah preached until he entered the Ark
- Jonah was sent to Nineveh
- Messages to the 7 churches
- Judgments represented in Revelations

Israel – Vehicle for Deliverance

- Pascha Meal (Passover) – 12:22, 27

Deliverance from Judgment

- Feasts of the Unleavened Bread –
12:17

Brought your hosts out of the land
of Egypt

God's Plan for Redemption Vehicle for Deliverance

Deliverance from Penalty of Sin

(Justification) Col 2:14 Blotting out the handwriting of ordinances that was against us, which was contrary to us, and took it out of the way, nailing it to his cross;

Deliverance from this Egypt

(Glorification) I Thess 4:16-17

God's Plan for Redemption

Vehicle for Deliverance

Deliverance from the bondage of sin (Sanctification)

- Clean out the leaven (Ex 19-20) or purge the old leaven (I Cor 5:7-8; Eph 5:25-27)

God's Plan for Redemption

- Permanent Ordinance Forever
(Ex 12:14; 24; 13:4; Deut 16:1)
- Testify to the generations
(Ex 12:26-27)
- Cut off if not observed (Num 9:13)

EXODUS



Pascha Meal (Passover)

- Lamb without blemish had to be chosen (12:3-6; John 1:29; I Peter 1:19&20; Heb 4:14-15)
- Lamb's Blood was shed and applied (12:7; 22; Eph 1:7)
- Lamb was roasted with fire (12:8-9; Mat 27:46; II Cor 5:21)

Pascha Meal (Passover)

- Unleavened Bread
 - Hastiness as they left Egypt (12:39)
 - Absence of leaven - Freedom from their old life



Pascha Meal (Passover)

- Bitter Herbs
 - Reminder of the past slavery – bitterness of sin

EXODUS



Rules for Participation

More than one household could share one lamb

Nothing shall be left for the morning and leftovers shall be burned (Exodus 12:10)

Eat in Haste - Exodus 12:11 (***1 Thess 4:13-17; James 5:8 – Parable of the Ten Virgins***)

It shall be eaten only inside the house

The lambs leg is not to be broken

No foreigner can eat of it

Deliverance

Death of the Firstborn

Pharaoh calls for Moses (10:28 Vs 12:31)

Israel is asked to leave immediately (12:32; 11:1)

- Take your flocks and herds
- Bless me also
- Leave in haste
- We will give you what you want

Israel starts the wilderness journey as God's redeemed
