- You shall be Holy- separated from other nations and solely devoted to God -*

Torah - Aseret ha-Dibrot

Rabbinical Texts: Aseret ha-D'varim

“10 Sayings” or “10 statements”

“Dabar” (Daw Baw)

“Mitzvot” – “Commandments”

Aseret ha-Mitzvot – “10 Commandments”



Jewish (10 Sayings)	Protestant (10 Commandments)
I am Adonai your God who brought you out from the Land of Egypt, from the house of bondage (Exodus 20:2)	You shall have no other gods before me (Exodus 20:3)
You shall have no other gods before me (Ex 20:3)	You shall not make unto you any graven images (Ex 20:4)
You shall not take the name of your God in vain	You shall not take the name of your God in vain
You shall remember the Sabbath and keep it Holy	You shall remember the Sabbath and keep it Holy



The Giving of the Law

First Saying

Ps 100:1-3 ¶

Make a joyful shout to the LORD, all you lands!

Ps 100:2 Serve the LORD with gladness; Come before His presence with singing.

Ps 100:3 Know that the LORD, He is God; It is He who has made us, and not we ourselves; We are His people and the sheep of His pasture.

The Giving of the Law

John 4:23-26

4:23 "But the hour is coming, and now is, when the true worshipers will worship the Father in spirit and truth; for the Father is seeking such to worship Him.

4:24 "God is Spirit, and those who worship Him must worship in spirit and truth."

4:25 The woman said to Him, "I know that Messiah is coming" (who is called Christ). "When He comes, He will tell us all things."

4:26 Jesus said to her, "I who speak to you am He."
