Meaning: 'The Utter and Complete Confidence in the Word of God'

God used three signs:

- Sign of the Staff – A sign of God's power
Staff represents power

EXODUS



It depends on whose hands it's in:

- A basketball in my hands is worth about \$19.
- A basketball in Michael Jordan's hands is worth about \$33 million – It depends on whose hands it's in.
- A baseball in my hands is worth about \$6.
- A baseball in Barry Bond's hands is worth \$19 million – It depends on whose hands it's in.
- A tennis racket is useless in my hands.
- A tennis racket in Roger Federer's hands is a Wimbledon Championship – It depends on whose hands it's in.

- A rod in my hands will keep away a wild animal.
- A rod in Moses' hands will part the mighty sea
– It depends on whose hands it's in.
- A sling shot in my hands is a kid's toy.
- A sling shot in David's hand is a mighty weapon
– It depends on whose hands it's in.
- Two fish and five loaves of bread in my hands is a couple of fish sandwiches.
- Two fish and five loaves of bread in God's hands will feed thousands – It depends on whose hands it's in.
- Nails in my hands might produce a birdhouse.
- Nails in Jesus Christ's hands will produce salvation for the entire world – It depends on whose hands it's in.

God used three signs:

- Sign of the Staff – A sign of God's power
Staff represents power
- Sign of a Leprous Hand – A sign of God's holiness
Leprosy represents sin
- Sign of blood – A sign of God's judgment
Blood represents Judgment

SELF-PITY

Meaning: ‘Self pity is sorrowing over one’s own misfortunes or weaknesses’

EXODUS



1 Corinthians 1:26-29 *For consider your calling, brethren, that there were not many wise according to the flesh, not many mighty, not many noble; 27 but God has chosen the foolish things of the world to shame the wise, and God has chosen the weak things of the world to shame the things which are strong, 28 and the base things of the world and the despised God has chosen, the things that are not, so that He may nullify the things that are, 29 so that no man may boast before God.*

Eugene Peterson in his paraphrase – *‘That none of you can get by with blowing your own horn before God’*
