EXODUS 3:14





MAIN IDEA:

The key to deliverance from bondage is to know Him more.

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Names of God	Significance	First Occurrence

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Jehovah:

- The most distinctive name of God in the OT
- Occurs about 6800 times in the Hebrew text

'YHWH'
TETRAGRAMMATON

Root word: '*hayah*', meaning '*to be*' or '*to become*'

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Some examples:

- **Genesis 2:7** *Then the LORD God formed man of dust from the ground, and breathed into his nostrils the breath of life; and man became (hayah) a living being.*
- **Genesis 2:24** *For this reason a man shall leave his father and his mother, and be joined to his wife; and they shall become (hayah) one flesh.*
- **Genesis 39:2** *The LORD was with Joseph, so he became (hayah) a successful man. And he was in the house of his master, the Egyptian.*

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The name 'Jehovah' reveals the following:

1. Self-existent God

Exodus 15:11 *"Who is like You among the gods, O LORD? Who is like You, majestic in holiness, Awesome in praises, working wonders?"*

Psalms 86:8 *There is no one like You among the gods, O Lord, Nor are there any works like Yours.*

Psalms 71:19 *For Your righteousness, O God, reaches to the heavens, You who have done great things; O God, who is like You?*

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1. The Covenant keeping God:

Genesis 15:13-14 *God said to Abram, “Know for certain that your descendants will be strangers in a land that is not theirs, where they will be enslaved and oppressed four hundred years. But I will also judge the nation whom they will serve, and afterward they will come out with many possessions.”*

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1. The Redeemer God:

Exodus 6:6 *"Say, therefore, to the sons of Israel, 'I am the LORD, and I will bring you out from under the burdens of the Egyptians, and I will deliver you from their bondage. I will also redeem you with an outstretched arm and with great judgments.*

Matthew 1:21 *"She will bear a Son; and you shall call His name Jesus, for He will save His people from their sins."*

JESUS – ‘YAHSHUA’ in Hebrew
‘YAH’ – ‘Jehovah’
‘OSHUA’ – Savior

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Jesus Christ is:

1. The self existent

John 8:58 *Jesus said to them, "Truly, truly, I say to you, before Abraham was born, I am." – The self-existent One*

4. The Covenant God

1 Corinthians 11:25 *In the same way He took the cup also after supper, saying, "This cup is the new covenant in My blood; do this, as often as you drink it, in remembrance of Me*

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Jesus Christ is:

1. The Redeemer God

Ephesians 1:7 In Him we have redemption through His blood, the forgiveness of our trespasses, according to the riches of His grace

1 Peter 1:18 knowing that you were not redeemed with perishable things like silver or gold from your futile way of life inherited from your forefathers,

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Jesus Christ is:

1. A Personal God

- *I AM the bread of life.*
- *I AM the door of the sheep.*
- *I AM the good shepherd*
- *I AM the resurrection and the life*
- *I AM the way, and the truth, and the life*
- *I AM the true vine, and My Father is the vinedresser*
- *While I am in the world, I AM the Light of the world.*

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THEME for this Series:

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Phil 3:8-10

- More than that, I count all things to be loss in view of the surpassing value of *knowing Christ Jesus* my Lord, for whom I have suffered the loss of all things, and count them but rubbish so that I may gain Christ,
9 and may be *found in Him*, not having a righteousness of my own derived from the Law, but that which is through faith in Christ, the righteousness which comes from God on the basis of faith,
