- ❖ Christ = "The anointed One"

John prepares the way for Jesus

Water baptism = External symbol; produced no change in person's life

Spirit baptism= "For even as the body is one and yet has many members, and all the members of the body, though they are many, are one body, so also is Christ. For by one Spirit we were all baptized into one body, whether Jews or Greeks, whether slaves or free, and we were all made to drink of one Spirit." **1 Corinthians 12:12-13**

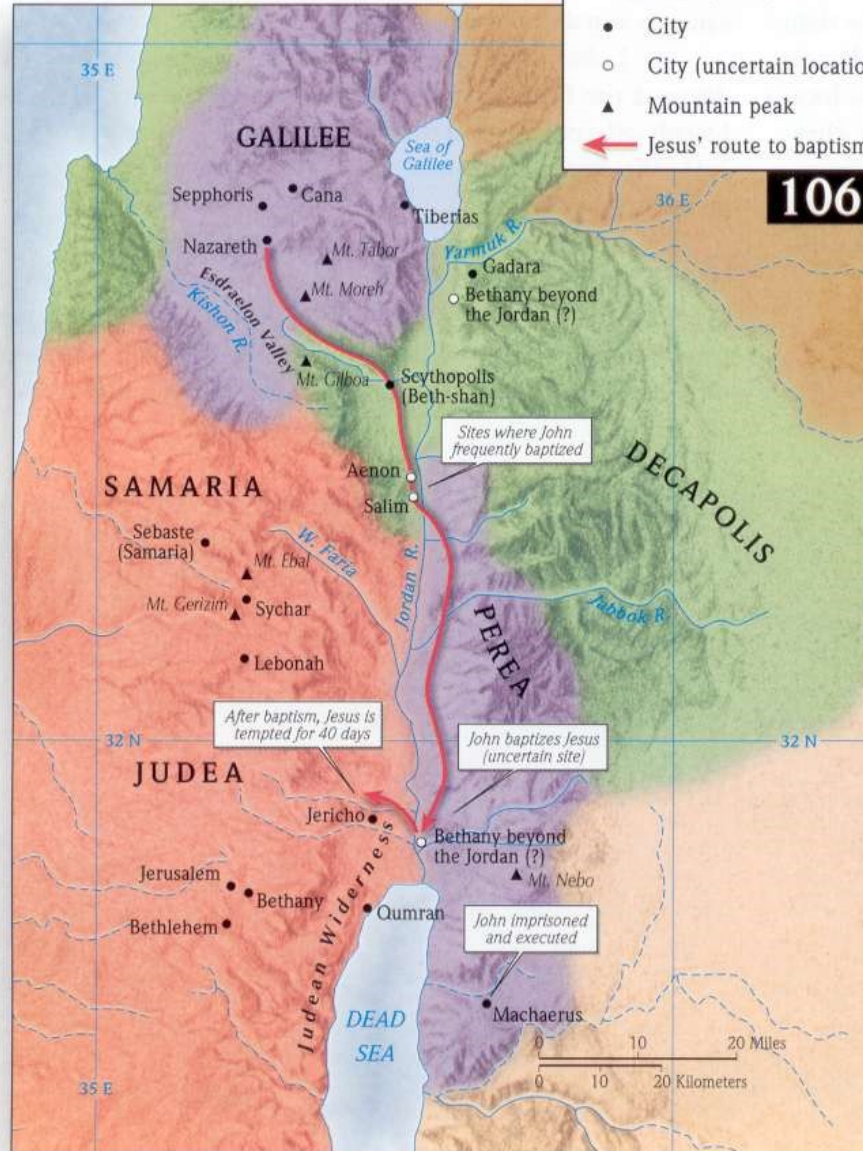
John baptizes Jesus

John baptizes Jesus

- ❖ Jesus travels 60 miles
- ❖ Jesus authenticates John's message
- ❖ Jesus does *NOT* confess any sin

Jesus did not need to confess any sin

“For we do not have a high priest who cannot sympathize with our weaknesses, but One who has been tempted in all things as we are, yet without sin.” **Hebrews 4:15**

“He made Him who knew no sin to be sin on our behalf, so that we might become the righteousness of God in Him.” **2 Corinthians 5:21**

“You know that He appeared in order to take away sins; and in Him there is no sin.” **1 John 3:5**

John baptizes Jesus

- ❖ Jesus travels 60 miles
